(5) This permit is a revocable permit and may be revoked at the discretion of the Tourism,

Arts and Heritage Cabinet, the Kentucky Department of Parks, or an agency designee upon 24 hours' notice, or without notice if damage to resources or facilities is threatened, notwithstanding any other term or condition of the permit to the contrary.

- (6) The applicant hereby agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Tourism, Arts and Heritage Cabinet, the Kentucky Department of Parks, its agents, officers, and employees, from any and all claims, damages, suits at law or equity of whatever kind of nature for damages to or loss of property or injury or death to persons, including applicant and/or its agent or employee, resulting directly or indirectly from or attributable to the applicant or its agent or employees in connection with the filming activities authorized by this permit.
- (7) For all types of operations conducted in Kentucky state parks, the applicant agrees to obtain as appropriate general, auto, and/or public liability insurance insuring against injury or death to any person or persons, or damage to any property, with liability limits of no less than \$1,000,000, insuring against all liability of applicant, its agents, vendors and employees arising out of and in connection with applicant's use of Park premises, and shall name the Commonwealth as an additional insured. The applicant shall provide Parks with proof of insurance before commencing production on Parks property.

This contract is subject to the terms and conditions as stated. By affixing signatures below, the parties agree that electronic approvals may serve as electronic signatures. In addition, the parties verify that they are authorized to bind this agreement between parties and that they accept the terms of the agreement.
